<b>Cost:</b>	\$1.4 million
<b>Debut:</b>	June 2004
<b>Track length:</b>	548 feet
<b>Description:</b>	Extreme white water rafting experience
<b>Special features:</b>	10-foot-wide open channels and 9- and 12-foot-diameter tunnels that create dark caverns along winding bends with steep drops  Rafts are propelled through a "wall of fog"  Ride setting takes advantage of Dollywood's Splash Country's unique mountain terrain
<b>Rafts:</b>	5-passenger maximum capacity
<b>Speed:</b>	18 feet per second; ride can serve up to 1,000 passengers an hour
<b>Location:</b>	Big Bear Ridge, a new themed area reminiscent of the Smoky Mountain's turn-of-the-century logging industry.
